

Sir Garfield's reference to Eichmann

CANBERRA: — The forthcoming Eichmann trial was mentioned in Federal Parliament recently during a statement by the Attorney-General and Acting Minister for External Affairs (Sir Garfield Barwick) on the Soviet request for surrender of Estonian E. R. A. P. Viks to the Soviet Union.

(The Russian request alleges that Viks personality participated in the mass shooting of Soviet citizens near Tartu in July, 1941.)

Sir Garfield Barwick said that migrants who have been allowed to make their homes in Australia, must be able to live, in security, new lives under the rule of law.
