

TRIAL FIGURES

JERUSALEM (Itim).—Nearly 70,000 people, including 600 correspondents from 50 countries, attended the trial of Adolph Eichmann in Jerusalem.

It lasted 16 weeks, during which time the court sat for 387 hours. A hundred and eleven witnesses — 11 from abroad — appeared, and they, with the 16 witnesses examined

in overseas courts, gave evidence in six languages. There are 1½ million words in the Hebrew protocol, covering 3,498 pages.

Sixty-six countries screened television and cinema films of the trial. 9,000 photographs were sold to the press and 972 radio-telephone conversations and 1,232 broadcasts brought news of the mass murder trial to people all over the world.
