

SON WRITES TO EICHMANN:

“ You Are Still My Father ”

LONDON: A letter, purporting to be a communication from Klaus Eichmann, son of the ex-Gestapo colonel, to his father who is awaiting trial in Israel, has been released in Jerusalem.

The letter is reported to have been brought to Israel by representatives of the Hamburg pictorial “Der Stern.”

Written from Buenos Aires, it said: “There are so many rumors here that we have no alternative but to believe that you really are Adolph Eichmann.

“You will understand that even if the accusations against you are proved, you still remain my father and

I your elder son who will never leave you.

“I shall take care of mother and the other children. I know nothing of her whereabouts now, but was assured she is well. Our house is empty now and closed.

“The fence has been repaired and the flowers are fine. I write you all this, because I know you will be glad to hear about it.”

The letter goes on to describe how difficult life has become, because of the press publicity and how things might be improved if the family changed its name.

“... But mother wouldn't hear of it. You know what she is like and it's no use

she is like and it's no use arguing with her, especially now, when we should all stick together . . .”
