"No feelings of guilt", Eichmann

TEL-AVIV: I learn on the most reliable authority that according to Elchmann's law-yer Robert Servatius, Elch-mann told him "I have no feelings of guilt, I had to earry out orders. If it were up to me to issue such orders I would not have done it."

Servatius quoted Elchmann as saying also that "perhaps I will be hanged but I never gave orders of this kind."

Servatius added that Eichmann will not do as other Nazi officers and officials did at Nuremberg trials. He will give all the facts to the court to decide whether he was guilty.
